This four- day festival will include intensive workshops and lessons in various styles of shakuhachi playing (Chikuho, Chikushinkai, Kinko and Tozan), from traditional to cutting edge contemporary. The festival is for beginners to advanced players, with a special discount and instruments available for absolute beginners. The Masters' Concert (Dec.15th, Orvis Hall, University of Hawai'i) will inaugurate the festivities with a performance of outstanding musicians from both Japan and Hawai'i. The festival will also feature an academic session presenting the latest in shakuhachi research.

Participation Fees include access to all concerts, workshops, private lessons, and academic sessions (\$25 discount on all fees with early bird discount until November 1st 2017)
Regular: \$350 (\$325 early bird), Hawaii Kama'aina: \$300 (\$275 early bird)

Absolute Beginner: \$175 (\$150 early bird)



SHAKUHACHI FESTIVAL:

To register for the Shakuhachi Festival of the Pacific, 2017, please use this form. After we receive your initial registration, an invoice for a non-refundable \$105 (\$100 registration fee + \$5 handling fee) deposit will be sent to you by email. The initial deposit is done through Paypal (HawaiiShakuhachi@gmail.com), with the remainder of the participation fees payable by check or cash at the time of registration. If you want to pay the full registration amount upfront, you can pay be check. Make checks payable to: Kyle Chew at 2684 Onu Place, Kalaheo, HI 96741

The festival costs are as follows:

- Normal: \$325 early bird, \$350 full
- Kama'aina (Hawaiian resident): \$275 early bird, \$300 full
- Absolute Beginner: \$150 early bird, \$175 full

Note: Early bird prices are available until Nov. 1st, 2017.

Accommodations:

The festival has reserved a few inexpensive rooms at the East West Center (EWC) for the nights of Dec. 15th to Dec. 18th. EWC housing is located on the University of Hawai'i campus, just minute walk from the venue.

- Lincoln Hall suites (single or double occupancy with kitchenette), \$56/night
- Dormitory single (shared restroom, kitchen) \$32/night
- Dormitory double (shared restroom, kitchen; single or double occupancy) \$43/night

You can make your reservations after we receive your \$105 deposit. Please note that accommodation availability is NOT guaranteed, so please make your reservations as soon as possible, as there are only limited rooms available. All accommodation reservations



must be made by November 15, 2017. Accommodation Cancellation fees will apply, as follows:

- 60 days or more in advance—no charge
- 30-59 days in advance—one night's cost per room
- Less than 30 days in advance—two-night room costs

In addition to the EWC accommodations, there are inexpensive hotels or AirBnBs in Waikiki, located a short bus ride to the campus.
